Aims of the farm visit

A trained member of staff from our farm team will introduce you to the animals and will give your group some facts about the different animals.

What it includes

- You can have a free pre visit for teachers, an experienced member of staff will talk to you at your pre visit. Our aim is to ensure the visit meets your curriculum needs.

- On the day an experienced member of staff will talk to the pupils about the farm, the animals and working as a farmer with an opportunity to hold, feel & smell the animal food to understand the animals way of life.
- You may have an opportunity during your visit to bottle feed calves or lambs.
- See the baby chicks (between April & September).
- We are developing a children's project garden area.
- A tractor & trailer ride.
- A warm area for the children to eat their packed lunch or Amerton Lunch Box.
- Use of Billy's Play Barn.


Meet the animals

Your pupils can experience meeting our animals on the playground or sports field, if you prefer.

Billy's Farm Barn



Billy's Farm Barn is an indoor wooden play area that children love to explore, climbing and being adventurous on all the equipment. The buildings represent the local village of Stowe by Chartley with a farmhouse, grain store, the pub, old village school, village hall, church and Granny Shaw's black and white thatched cottage.

We have a cyber room for the older children and a baby sensory area for the younger children. Groups of 10 or more children can visit Billy's Farm Barn for £6.99 per child, teachers and adults are free.


